

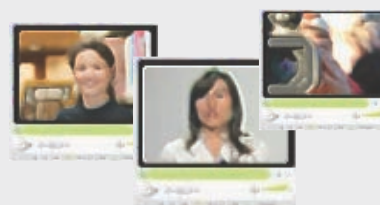

The V.I.D.E.O. Project is focused on the development of a new, innovative tool -the Video Curriculum-, meant to help the matching between the job demand and supply, with particular focus on a target of over 45 adults.

The development of meta-competences as self marketing and self-consciousness techniques and capability, have become goals of the most efficient guidance interventions. The Video-CV can be, in this framework, regarded as a particularly effective tool to answer to the complexity of occupational integration and re-integration processes that becomes critical for those job seekers who, though they hold competences and skills, very often acquired informally, cannot properly compete in the labour market also because they are scarcely able to communicate and valorise them.

In this context, the Video-CV represents one of the new, possible frontiers in the world of the personnel recruitment, one of the ways to let the employers know “who I am and what I can do”.

V.I.D.E.O. is a transnational project, co-financed within the LLP Programme - Leonardo da Vinci sub-programme.



The Project main aims are:

- To integrate and strengthen the guidance and counselling services offer, with communication tools and technologies;
- To design a web-based platform, able to host Video CV and facilitate the matching between labour demand and supply;
- To strengthen the efficacy of the applicant on the labour market;
- To disseminate the autobiographic guidance modality, contributing to the development of self-esteem and self-evaluation ability in recognising strengths and weaknesses of one’s own professional profile;
- To acquire proper competences in the use of multimedia communication tools, both by operators and job seekers;
- To arise consciousness on the communication potentiality of Videos;
- To offer to guidance operators the opportunity of acquiring ICT competences useful to support their role and daily work.

The main products that will be realised within the V.I.D.E.O. Project are:

- A Model for the realisation of the Video -CV tool;
- A Training Curriculum for operators and technicians;
- Experimentation and adoption of the Video Curriculum tool by counselling and employment centres in the participating countries;
- A database of around 40 Video Curricula published on project website;
- A Handbook on “*guidelines to the use and creation of the Video Curriculum tool*” addressed to counsellors, vocational guidance operators, technicians.
