### 14.30

The meeting is starting at 14.30 pm at the seat of COL (Center for Vocational Guidance) Tosi.

Antonella Barile is asking to her colleagues to start presenting the people selected for the pilot samples shootings.

Giuseppe Crupi is presenting 2 people's story. The people proposed by him are 35 and 37 years old. Both the people are coming from bourgeois families but had many problems in finding a job.

He is saying that he chose those people because they are both able to support the emotional stress of a Video-CV and because of the relevance of their personal stories.

After Mr. Crupi's speech, Alessia Mazza is presenting the cases of 40 years old two people, both having been in jail for crimes related to drug.

Both the people succeeded in rehabilitating themselves thanks to the cooperation of the COL Carceri.

Antonella Barile is then reading a communication sent by Fabrizio Cucculelli, who chose the case of a 40 years old woman being interested in being protagonist of a Video-CV sample. She has very good communicational skills and abilities having been working for many years as a front officer.

Besides, Antonella Barile is presenting the case of a 37 years old man just arrived in Rome. He has been working successfully for many years in a small shop, where he used to take care of the merchandising and to be responsible for the whole management of the store. He has been fired due to the store failure.

Fiore Ranauro is presenting the cases of two people (one 35 years old, one 45 years old).

The first case is a 35 years old man who has a diploma and who has been working as a lithographer. At the moment, he is attending a course for web designer.

The second case is a the 45 years old man, having been in jail for crimes related to drug traffic and having been working, while in prison, for the project "Radio Taxi" of the City of Rome.

At the end of the presentations, the attendants discuss together about the cases presented. At the end of the discussion, it is decided that the three people protagonists of the Video-CV samples will be:

1. Domenico (case presented by Giuseppe Crupi from the COL Cenci);
2. Lucia (case presented by Antonella Barile on behalf of Fabrizio Cucculelli from the COL Pasolini);
3. Stefano (case presented by Antonella Barile from the COL Tosi)

The last two mentioned people have already accepted to record the Video-CV.

Attendants agree that all the other 6 cases presented will be included in the number of the 20 Video-CVs to be produced before the end of the project.

Furthermore, participants agree on the necessity to prepare a text of about 1500-600 strokes (12 lines) presenting each applicant. These texts will be used by the counselors to train and prepare the applicants for the Video-CV shootings, and will be used also as a sort of plot to help the protagonists of the Video-CV samples during the shootings.

Attendants agree to meet again on the 17<sup>th</sup> of September to discuss about the texts for the three Video-CV samples.
